Opposite Concepts Sorting



Suggestions:

1. Print out pages 2 and 3 (final product: 2 folders with 6 pairs in each)
2. Cut out one picture of each pair of opposites and glue them into a folder with each card starting a new row
3. Laminate the folder
4. Place a velcro piece next to each glued card
5. Attached an envelope to the back of the folder for spare cards
6. Laminate, cut out, and velcro the other picture from each pair of opposites
7. Place individual pieces into an envelope

9. Modify to meet individual needs of your students!

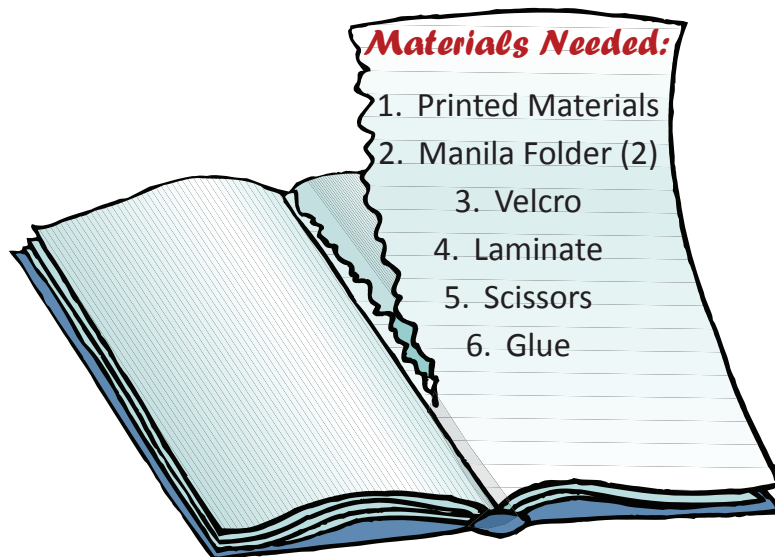
