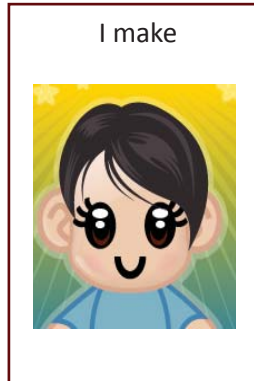

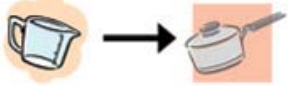



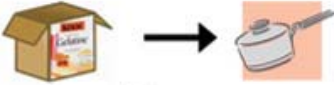









- ◇ Schedule (see p. 2)

- ◇ 1 package Jell-O (any flavor)
- ◇ 1 package gelatin
- ◇ 1 pot
- ◇ 1 spoon
- ◇ 1 bowl
- ◇ Candy mold (available at craft stores)
- ◇ Access to a stove

Time to make gummy candy!

- Measure 1/3 cup water. 
- Pour water into small pot. 
- Open Jell-O. 
- Pour Jell-O in pot. 
- Open gelatin. 
- Pour gelatin in pot. 
- Turn on stove to medium heat. 
- Put pot on burner. 
- Stir pot for 3 minutes. 
- Turn off stove. 
- Wait 1 minute for gelatin to cool. 
- Pour gelatin mixture into bowl. 
- Pour gelatin into mold. 
- Put gummy mold in to fridge. 
- Take a break. 
- Remove gummies from fridge.
