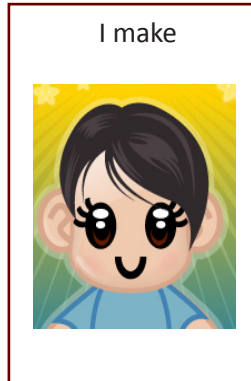

**Pilgrim Father says, "I am hungry! My tummy is rumbling!"**

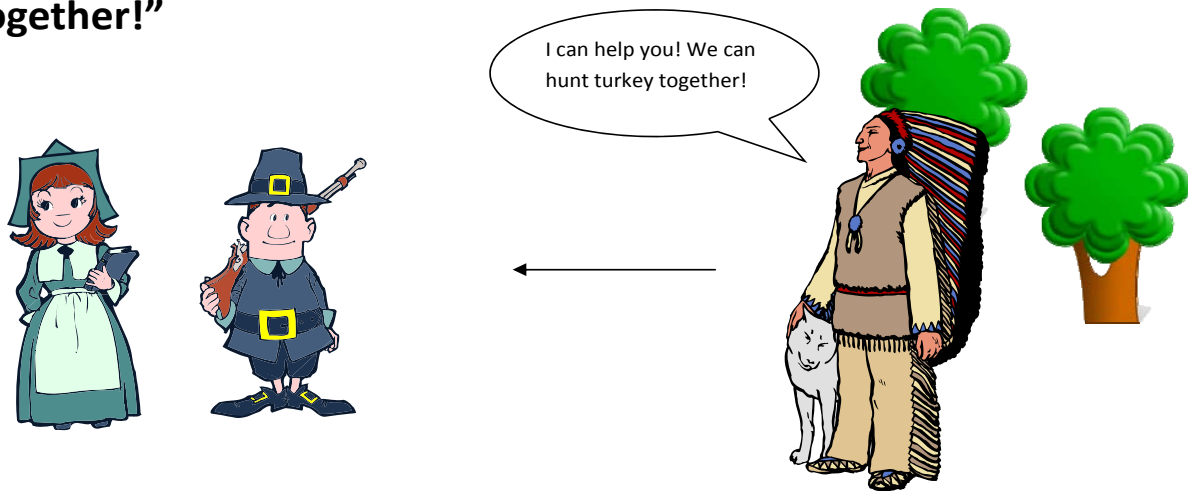

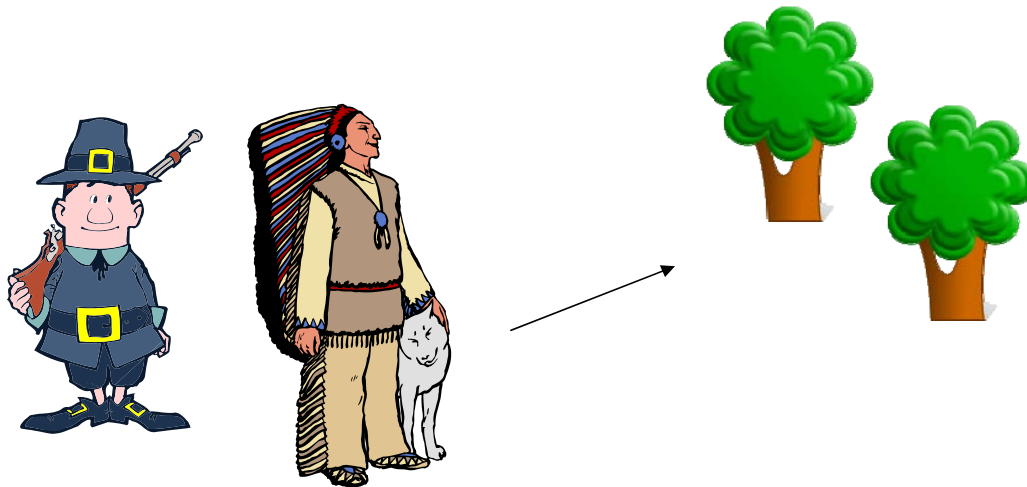
**Pilgrim Mother says, "I am very hungry too!"**

**Pilgrim Father and Indian go to the forest to hunt turkey.**



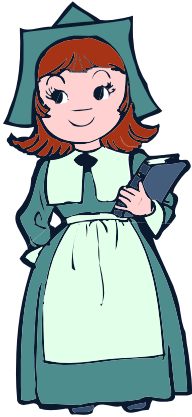
**Indian and Pilgrim Father return with a big turkey.**



**Pilgrim Mother says, "Hooray! I will roast this turkey!"**



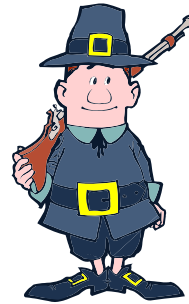
**Pilgrim Mother gets some corn and pumpkin to have with turkey.**
