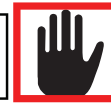


Time to make rice krispie treats!

wash hands



wait for a grown-up to turn on stove



put 3 tablespoons of butter in pan



wait for butter to melt



pour the bag of marshmallows into the pan



stir marshmallows until melted



wait for teacher to turn off stove



put 6 scoops of rice krispies into pan



stir rice krispies and marshmallows together with spoon 10 times



scoop mixture into long pan using spoon



put long pan into refrigerator
